

**WATT BROTHERS SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

The Watt Brothers Scholarship Awards are being given for outstanding citizenship, leadership qualities, moral character, and scholarship with special interest in the students' concern for their community. This year, scholarships of \$4,000 each at four year schools and \$2,000 each at two year schools, will be awarded. The scholarships are not based solely on financial need, and are not necessarily a high academic scholarship.

Upon receipt by the Trust of proof of registration, award money will be forwarded to the educational institution, in the recipient's name, as each term or semester commences. The recipient may use the scholarship in any field of study.

RULES

1. All applications must be delivered to the office of the Trust located at 2216 Fourth Street, P.O. Box 999, Tillamook, Oregon 97141. **The applications must be in the hands of the Scholarship Committee before 4:00 p.m. on Friday, June 5, 2020. No application will be accepted later than that day and hour.** The telephone number is 503-842-4417.
2. Applicant shall have received part of their education in the Tillamook County School system.
3. Applicant shall be in pursuit of any type of post high school education. The applicant must be a high school senior from a high school in Tillamook County.
4. The Scholarship Award Committee may interview applicants.
5. The members of the Scholarship Award Committee shall consist of at least two designated representatives of the Watt family.
6. Each recipient of a Scholarship award will be eligible for a second year award providing they maintain a full time course load, approximately a 3.0 grade point average, provide the committee with a grade report for the first year, and submit a statement of intent to continue their education and which institution they will attend for the 2021-2022 year, by July 9, 2021.
7. Awards recipients will be notified by July 31, 2020.

- 2 . Four-year high school transcripts.
- 3 . SAT test scores.
